Every autumn, deciduous trees and shrubs shed their leaves. In some years, leaves are shed earlier than in others. Why does this happen?

The crop is harvested in the winter after leaf fall. New shoots emerge the following spring from the 'stool' or stump and are then allowed to grow for three years.

Leaves start the process of "falling" when the nights get longer. The chemicals at the base of the leaves weaken the cell layer there to the point.
